Semester 2021B Fast Track

Call for Proposals

The Chilean Telescope Time Allocation Committee (CNTAC) invites the Chilean community to submit proposals through its fast track modality. The telescopes and time offered in each of them are:

1. **REM**: 20 hours available
2. **Smarts 1m**: 167 hours available
3. **Speculoos**: 78 nights available
4. **SARA**: 6 nights available.
5. **KASI** : 13 nights available.
6. **TRAPPIST**: 18 nights available.
7. **TAROT**: 60 hours available.
8. **EXTRA**: 30 nights available.

Fast-track proposals will be handled directly by the CNTAC Chair and Panel Chairs.

Proposals must be sent to: cntac@das.uchile.cl with the subject "CNTAC 2021B Fast Track" + telescope_name + PI_lastname. Deadline for submission is

Friday, June 4, 2021 at NOON, Chilean Standard time.

All CNTAC rules apply (see Call for Proposals at http://www.das.uchile.cl/das_cntac.html for details), except that there will be no consideration for long term programs in the Fast track call.

DO NOT submit proposals through the CNTAC webpage. Proposals should be submitted in pdf format using the same standard as regular proposals (see the CfP for details). Please note that proposals that do not use the (unaltered) latex template or that are longer than the page limit will not be considered.

You must include a cover page with the following information:

- PI information (name, email, affiliation, status: student, faculty, etc.)
- COIs information: name, email, affiliation.
- Proposal information:
Title, abstract, telescope, instrument, time requested (both preferred and minimum), preferred dates, Moon requirements, etc.
